**PICK-UP AND DROP-OFF LOCATIONS**

The Caldwell pick-up and drop-off location will be at the Sinclair gas station, exit #29, off I-84. The van will be parked at the entrance to the Sage Café restaurant at approximately **8:15am**. The Nampa pick-up and drop-off location will be at the Noodles restaurant, exit #36, off I-84. The van will arrive at this location at approximately **8:45am**. Please be patient, one parent being late puts us a few minutes later at every stop. The pick-up and drop-off location for Boise area is located at the Western Idaho Fairgrounds, across the street from Westy's Garden Lanes. Children will be picked up at this location between **9:15am-9:30am**. We will do our best to be at these locations on time, however please allow us a few minutes either way.

Be sure to tell your parents that we'll be back at the Fairgrounds early **Friday** evening around **6:30pm**. For those of you coming from the Caldwell or Nampa area we'll be returning you to the appropriate drop-off locations between **7:00 and 7:30pm**.
