PICK-UP AND DROP-OFF LOCATIONS

The Caldwell pick-up/drop-off location will be at the Sinclair Gas Station, exit #29, off I-84. We will meet between 8:15-8:30am Monday morning just west of the propane fill-up station. The **new** Nampa pick-up and drop-off location will be at the Franklin Junction gas station/convenience store on the corner of Hwy. 20/26 and N. Franklin Blvd. The van will arrive at this location at approximately 8:45am.

The pick-up/drop-off location for Boise area is located at the Western Idaho Fairgrounds, across the street from Westy's Garden Lanes near the bridge that crosses the park canal. Children will be picked up at this location between 9:15am-9:30am. We will do our best to be at these locations on time however please allow us a few minutes either way.
